Many of the Deaf, Deafblind, and seniors that we service have higher than average comorbidities, are some of the most medically and socially at-risk citizens, and often live below the poverty line.

Our Impact

- In 2024-2025, we provided services to 56,745 Deaf, Deafblind, and hard of hearing individuals.
 - This included 8,068 new clients an increase of 3.8% compared to new clients the previous fiscal year.

- We delivered 252,013 appointments across a range of programs including:
